“How to” Guide, Beginner Level: Answer Key

1. Interpret the following notes in the **Film/Digital Notes** section of the FamilySearch Catalog entry for Langwasser, Schlesien, Preussen, Germany. Indicate which contain right-side pages, left-side pages, or both. If a collection contains both, also indicate which side is first.

Tote 1766-1790 (r. & l. S.)	Both; right-side pages filmed first.
Taufen 1781-1797 (l. S.) Heiraten 1738-1766 (r. & l. S.) Tote 1737-1766 (r. & l. S.)	Taufen: Left-side pages only; Heiraten: both; right-side pages filmed first; Tote: both; right-side pages filmed first.
Taufen 1693-1711 (r. S.)	Right-side pages only.
Taufen 1597-1630 Taufen 1662-1719 (l. & r. S.)	Taufen 1597-1630: Both; normal book order; Taufen 1662-1719: Both; left-side pages first.

2. Find the FamilySearch Catalog entry for the parish of Sankt Michaels in Brixen, Tirol, Austria (now Bressanone, Bolzano, Italy). Identify the marriage record for Ferdinand Egger on 20 June 1922. Use the Tools feature in the FamilySearch images to adjust the brightness and contrast, if necessary. Answer the following questions:

Which microfilm(s) should you browse?	Film 1345130 (left side) Film 1345129 (right side)
On which image number(s) and page number(s) is the marriage found?	Image 13 (left side) and image 12 (right side). Both are on page 10.
What is the name of Ferdinand Egger's wife, and what additional information do you find about her?	Bride's name Ziazilia Ebner; religion <i>r.k.</i> (Roman Catholic); occupation <i>Dienstmagd</i> (servant girl) in Ellen; parents: Johann Ebner, farmer in Ellen, and Maria Zingerle in Ellen. Bride's birth date and place: 1 January 1888 in Ellen. Bride's marital status: single.
