1. Use the FamilySearch Catalog to answer the following questions regarding records for Mortera, Santander, Spain:

What is the film number of records available digitally?	1180904
What item number would I look for to begin searching <i>Bautismos</i> beginning in 1693?	Item 5
Which image number shows the beginning of Item 5?	412
How many images are available for this microfilm?	2297

2. Using the map on the FamilySearch Search page, locate Evangelical Church Birth records for the year 1878 in Breslau-St. Barbara, Wrocław, Poland and answer the following questions.

What is the name of the collection where these records can be found?	Poland, Evangelical Church Books, 1700-2005
What is the name of the collection that contains births for the year 1878?	Births (Akta urodzeń) 1877-1880
Are the records indexed?	No
How many images are available for this collection?	355
